



DISS & DISTRICT NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN CONSULTATION ON SUBMITTED PLAN (REG. 16)

South Norfolk Council and Mid Suffolk District Council have published the proposed Diss & District Neighbourhood Plan for public consultation. This multi-parish, cross-county boundary Neighbourhood Plan has been prepared by a volunteer working group, working on behalf of Diss Town Council and the surrounding parishes of Burston & Shimpling, Roydon and Scole (in South Norfolk), and Brome & Oakley, Palgrave and Stuston (in Mid Suffolk). The Plan has been prepared in consultation with residents and other stakeholders.

The Plan sets a framework for future development in this multi-parish area up to 2038 and, if successful, will be one of the main considerations in determining planning applications in the area, alongside the Local Plans.

Anyone wishing to comment on the proposed Neighbourhood Plan must do so before **4.00pm on Friday 16**th **December 2022**.
